JHU Weekly Campus Report

On Campus

Arrest-Trespassing/CCTV Monitoring-3100 Blk N.Charles St- July 16th at 12:28 AM, a male was observed on the CCTV walking into rear yard of the Hopkins building at 3103 N. Charles St. Campus officers identified him as a non-affiliate, gave him a trespass warning and ordered him to leave the area. At 1:05 AM, a campus officer and an off-duty Baltimore Police officer working for JHU observed the suspect trying a door handle of a parked car on 3100 blk of N. Charles St. The suspect was ARRESTED and charged with trespassing.

Off Campus

Burglary (Private Residence) – 2800 Blk. St. Paul St (even side)– On July 11th between 9:30 PM and 11:15 PM, a graduate student's laptop computer was taken from a rear bedroom of a 3rd floor apartment while the residents were in another room of the apartment. Entry was gained through an open 3rd floor balcony door. Baltimore Police responded. Investigation continuing.

Arrest-Trespass-115 W. University Pkwy (Carnegie Garage)- On July 13th at 5:04 PM, a graduate student

observed a suspicious unknown male looking into cars and when he saw her he hid behind a pillar and then left the garage area. A campus officer recognized observed male exiting the garage right after incident occurred. The male suspect, who was previously issued a trespass warning, was ARRESTED by a Baltimore Police Officer.

Attempt Unarmed Robbery (Purse Snatch)-3300 Keswick Rd (Hampden)- On July 14th at 12:10 PM, an employee walking in the 3300 Blk of Keswick Rd. was approached by two unknown male who ran up behind her and attempted to take her purse by force. The victim fell to the ground during the assault and began yelling for help. The two suspects fled westbound in the 700 block w.34th st. No property was taken Baltimore Police responded. The victim was treated at Occupational Health Services for minor injuries. Investigation continuing.

Burglary (Non-Affiliates Private Residence)- 2900 Blk. Wyman Parkway(even side) -On July 14th between 6:00 PM and 9:15 PM, a Nintendo console and a wireless "hotspot" internet device were taken from a non-affiliates house. The suspect had gained entry by cutting the outer screen of a rear window.

Burglary (Private Apartment Building) -2800 Blk Cresmont ave- On July 16th between 2:30 PM and 10:00 PM , a Laptop computer, digital camera and adigital recorder were taken from a School of Medicine employee's 5th floor apartment. No signs of forced entry to the victims apartment door.
