Residential Burglary

Unknown suspect climbed fire escape then forced a rear door open then unscrewed the bars that cover the window to gain entry. Suspect then removed listed property and fled w/same through the front door. Crime lab requested.

Weekly Campus Crime Report

April 20, 2009 – April 27, 2009 On Campus Theft – O’Connor Recreation Center – On April 18th from 6:30 – 6:50 PM, an undergraduate reported leaving his ZUNE MP3 player unattended on a treadmill. Upon returning the student found the MP3 missing. Lost and found checked with negative results. (Reported to Security April 22nd). Investigation continuing.

Common Assault (Alcohol Related) – Spring Fair, Beer Garden – April 25th at 5:33 PM, an intoxicated senior undergraduate shoved his hand in the face of senior undergraduate and then grabbed her sunglasses and broke them. No injuries were reported. The suspect ran when the victim said she was calling security. The suspect was stopped and identified by campus officers and a Baltimore Police Officer. Victim refused to pursue criminal charges. **Theft – Spring Fair, Freshman Quad** – April 25th at 7:20 PM, a graduate student’s bag, containing a laptop computer, Blackberry cell phone, keys and J-Card, was stolen as it lay unattended near a tree. Investigation continuing.

Off Campus

Unarmed Robbery (of Non-Affiliate) – E. 27th & St. Paul Sts. – On April 27th at 12:25 AM, a non-affiliated person waiting for an MTA bus was approached by two unknown males who asked him for money. When he said he had no money, one suspect went through his pockets and took a cell phone. No injuries. The two suspects then ran east on 27th St. Baltimore Police responded. Investigation continuing. Attempt Robbery (unarmed) – 300 Blk. E. 31st St. – On April 20th at 10:30 PM, a graduate student was accosted by two males who grabbed him, demanded money, went through his pockets and attempted to take his backpack. The student started speaking Russian which apparently confused the suspects who then fled westbound on 31st Street. Investigation continuing **CCTV Observation / Assault (Alcohol Related, Domestic Related) – 3300 Blk.**

N. Charles St. (east side) – April 25th at 1:17 AM, a non-affiliated male was struck by a non-affiliated female. Campus officers and an off-duty Baltimore Police officer working for Hopkins responded. The male declined medical attention for minor injuries and refused to pursue criminal charges.
