Couple Arrested In Charles Village Drug Bust

Police say the raid was the result of a month-long investigation into a man with a deep criminal history. Joseph Batson, 39, of Baltimore faces a list of more than 20 charges after a police raid uncovered a massive stash of powder and crack cocaine and several high powered handguns. It happened at his apartment in the 2900-block of Saint Paul Street. Investigators say they also found a 20 ton hydraulic kilo presser and a heat sealer used in the drug world to pack narcotics into easy to distribute bricks.

"He was on the upper level of mid-level distribution. Would we call him a kingpin? Not necessarily, but as far as what we find in Baltimore, he had an elaborate operation going on," said Detective Donnie Moses, Baltimore City Police. Police also arrested Batson's wife, Jamie Batson, 25, who was already on a home monitoring system. Court records show her husband has a criminal history involving drugs and guns, too. Police do not believe the couple was actually living inside the apartment, but that they were only using it to do business.

"You never know who your neighbors are now," said Rodney Davis, Charles Village. On the street known for its colorful character in a neighborhood known for its charm, many residents are disturbed. "It seems to me a lot of people who move to Charles Village expect a break from all the crime that happens in the city. People come for a sense of security, and they bring their kids out here," said Jake Dibeler, Charles Village. "To find someone had drugs in the neighborhood and they did get caught is fine, it's good. They need to get caught," said Davis.

The couple is being held at Central Booking. Joseph Batson is being held on no bond, while his wife's is set at \$3 million.

A preliminary hearing for both defendants is scheduled for early July.
