Crime Prevention Tips

As the weather gets colder and night comes quicker, here are some additional safety tips:

Safety Tip 1) When you are entering your neighborhood or area, especially at night, be aware of whether someone is behind you. If you see a car behind you that you are not familiar with, DO NOT STOP at your house or destination. Drive past to see whether you are really being followed. If you suspect you are, drive back out to a populated area and see whether they keep following you. Look for a fire station, a police station or somewhere else that is populated. Still being followed? Call 911 and let them know what is happening and where you are.

Safety Tip 2) Leaving items in your car in plain site is just an invitation to thieves. Take valuables with you or put them in your trunk out of site
