## Crime Prevention Tips

Do you have a day and night check list. Using a check list can help in preventing you from being the next victim.

Daily and Evening Check lists include

- Lock Front Door, Rear doors and any patio doors
- Check all windows. Make sure windows are locked when the room is not being occupied.
- Do not hide spare keys outside
- Do not leave items in front of windows
- Do not leave items of interest visible in your car (GPS, CD's, Money, even coin currency)
